Mr. Hildred Lewis McTush was born on December 28, 1949, in Rockford, IL to the late Lucille Grundy and Hildred “Mac” McTush. He departed this life on Tuesday, May 30, 2023.

Lewis spent the last 36 years with the love of his life, wife Teresa. Teresa and Lewis built a life together that included the birth of their daughter, Lindsey. When meeting Lewis, one often heard about the accomplishments of his daughters, one of his nieces or nephews, or his pride about his granddaughters.

Lewis was a man of many talents and life experiences. He was a respected community changemaker and CEO/Founder of LewMar Millennium Entertainment LLC, and Entertainers Speak Out. With his support and tireless efforts, he was key to the passing of the first smoke-free initiative in the State of Georgia and nationally. He was also a health equity advocate for the American Cancer Society, Center for Black Health & Equity, American Non-Smokers Rights Foundation, and Smokefree Music Cities.

He was a music lover and global traveler. He was an esteemed member of the Atlanta Blues Society. He loved sharing stories of the illustrious careers he influenced of such artists as Joss Stone, Shirley Jones, Theodis Ealey, Gwen

McCray, Menagerie Band, just to name a few.

Lewis is preceded in death by his four younger siblings Jeffrey McTush, Jacqueline McTush, William McTush, and Gregory McTush.
