“ I bring condolences to Idella’s family and friends on behalf of the Classmates of George Washington Carver High School of Carrollton, Georgia. The school opened in the fall of 1954 and closed in the spring of 1969 when all of Carroll County’s public schools had been desegregated.

Idella was a member of the Class of 1963, one of the most accomplished of Carver’s 14 graduating classes. Idella and her classmates lived through the historic times of the Jim Crow and Civil Rights eras including the assassinations of President John Kennedy, Reverend Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr, Robert Kennedy and Malcolm X. Many of her male classmates served in the Vietnam War. They are among the last generations to attend segregated schools in the state of Georgia.
