She enjoyed the singing, being a part of the prayer calls, and listening to the Word of God. She gave her life to the Lord at a young age and continued to mature in her Christian faith. Inez was affectionately known as “Auntie” and “Gramma Nez.” She enjoyed cooking, gardening, and collecting elephants. To this day she has a massive collection!

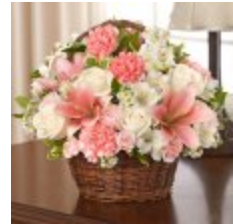
