Ivan Lee Winder Sr., son of Doll L. Winder and Russell L. Winder Sr. was born on June 30, 1972 in Lewis, DE. Ivan, transitioned, on Monday, June 10, 2024 at home, in Snellville, Georgia, he was 51.

Ivan was the second (2nd) of four (4) children. He received his early education in the Indian River School District and graduated high school from Sussex Central High School Georgetown, DE. Ivan also studied Masonry at Sussex Vo-Tech in Georgetown, Delaware. He attended Dickinson Chapel AME Church, Millsboro, DE in his adolescent years.

After graduating, he enlisted in the Military, choosing the Navy. Ivan excelled at K-9 Training and eventually became a Kennel Master, stationed in Iraq for all K-9's in that unit. He retired with over 20 plus years of faithful service, he eventually contracted with the Military doing K-9 Detection Services, and ended his professional career working at DHL.

Ivan met his wife, Mekdes Shifraw Winder, while serving overseas. They married, and went on to have one (1) beautiful child together, Javon Winder.

Ivan's keen sense of humor, smile and laugh would leave you wanting more. Ivan LOVED animals, cooking, grilling, sports and being outside, which started as a young boy. He joined the football team in his adolescence and was dubbed, Ivan The Terrible, as he would own and dominate his position as Line Backer. His major love of dogs and his ability to understand them is what shifted him to K-9 work. If you wanted to see Ivan in his happy place, training was it. To know him was to fall in love with him, and his zest for life! He was big on respect and had a work ethic like no other. He was kind, loving, passionate, creative, thoughtful, full of life, and loved his family. If you were able to be accepted into his life as a friend, you at that point, were family. Ivan was always fun, he lived every moment as if it was his last with no regrets. He was a protector, a provider, a confidant, no nonsense, and he loved working with his hands.

He had a passion to learn and share the information he came across with whoever he came in contact with. He enjoyed playing spades, and sports, as a Loyal Comanders (Redskin) fan. Sitting back sipping on a cold one, and having a smoke is how you would find him during football season.

Ivan was preceded in death by both of his paternal and maternal, grandmothers and grandfathers, as well as aunts and uncles.

Ivan leaves behind his wife Mekdes Shifraw Winder; two (2) sons, Javon Winder of Snellville, GA and Ivan Winder Jr. of Dover, DE; one (1) daughter Kayla Winder of Townsend, DE; mother Doll Winder of Dasgboro, DE; father

He didn't have a church home, but he knew the Grace and Mercy that God shows and FOREVER poured over his life. He was the definition of "Riding this thing till the wheels fall off".
