Miss Jacqueline Harpp was born on December 23, 1952 to the union of James and Elsie Harp in Stewart County, Georgia. She was known as “Jack or Jackie” by her family and friends.

Jacqueline graduated from Cusseta High School in 1970 as class Valedictorian and completed her studies in 1974 at Morris Brown College in Atlanta, Georgia, earning a Bachelor of Science Degree (BS) in Business Administration. After graduation, she was employed with the United States Government Accountability Office (GAO) and retired on December 16, 2010 after 37 years, plus 10 months and 24 days of service as a Senior Analyst.

Jacqueline enjoyed playing Scrabble competitively and was a member of the North American Scrabble Players Association (NASPA). She also enjoyed watching Jeopardy, The Price Is Right, The Young and Restless, collecting dolls and was a member of the Maryland Society of Doll Collectors, but most of all she cherished the time spent with her family and friends. Holiday gatherings at her home were so much fun. We will always remember her beautiful decorations, from the elegantly decorated Christmas trees, the specially crafted holiday table centerpieces and place settings to the delicious menu.

Jacqueline departed this life on Sunday, September 25, 2022 at Piedmont

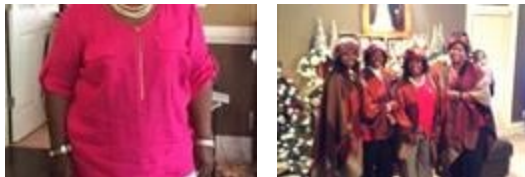
