Jaison Brown, 15, of Lawrenceville, GA, passed October 30th 2015 as a result of injuries sustained in a motor vehicle accident on his way to Dacula High School. He was born December 22, 1999 in New Rochelle, NY, the son of Paul and Merrill (Rose) Brown. From 2003-2005, Jaison attended Wake Eden Christian Academy in the Bronx, New York before relocating to Lawrenceville, GA in July 2005. Jaison completed elementary school at Alcova Elementary and middle school at Dacula Middle School. At the age of 5, Jaison began what would become his passion, soccer. His ability was immediately apparent and his speed was undeniable. As a junior at Dacula High School, he played on the varsity soccer team as midfield and striker. He also played on the UFA Norcross U-16 soccer team. Jaison will be remembered for his tenacious personality and the way he always supported and encouraged his fellow athletes, classmates, and friends. Jaison is survived by his parents, Paul and Merrill Brown of Lawrenceville; his brother Devin, 29 of Orlando, FL and his sister Markia, 9 of Lawrenceville. He also leaves his maternal Grandfather Raymond Rose of New York and paternal Grandparents, Rickmond Brown of New York and Pearlina Brown of Lawrenceville. He is survived by his girlfriend, Brooke De St. Germain and also a host of aunts, uncles, cousins and friends.
