Jared P. Brown, 17, of Lawrenceville, GA, passed October 30th 2015 as a result of injuries sustained in a motor vehicle accident on his way to Dacula High School. He was born April 27, 1998 in New Rochelle, NY, the son of Paul and Merrill (Rose) Brown. From 2000-2004, Jared attended Wake Eden Christian Academy in the Bronx, New York as well as Nativity of our Blessed Lady before relocating to Lawrenceville, GA in July 2005. Jared completed elementary school at Alcovia Elementary and middle school at Dacula Middle School. At the age of 7, Jared began what would be his passion, soccer. Jared worked hard to become a very technical player. As a senior at Dacula High School, he was a member of the varsity soccer team, African-Caribbean Student Association, H.O.P.E., Dacula Leadership team, Student Athlete Leadership team and the Spanish Club. 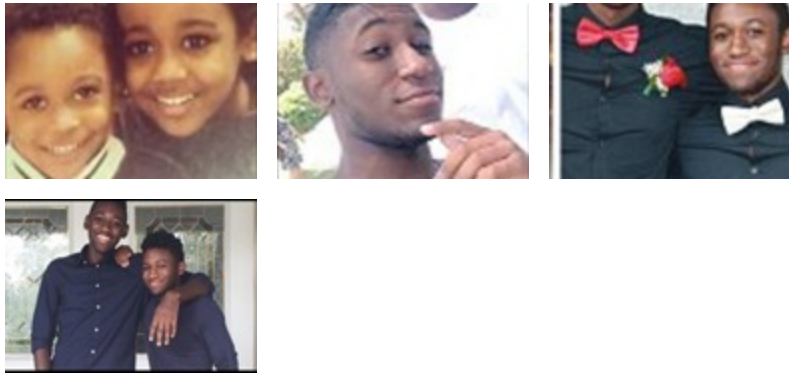
