Jeff was preceded in death by his parents and siblings, Peggy J. Pearson, Michael Jackson, and Curtis Lee Jackson Jr.

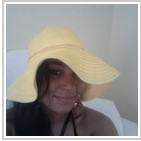

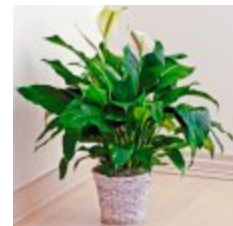

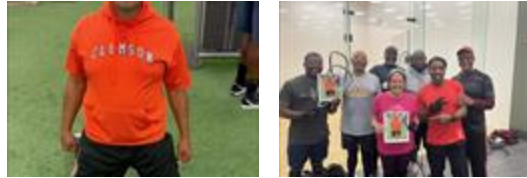
