God told me he was sending me back as an Angel in Training, I strive to be exactly that in caring, helping those in need and being of service to others. The third time I ssat up split open like a fish from chest to pelvis under anesthesia and asked if we were done yet. The two surgeons could not believe it and a nurse apssed out. I share this story because I shared it with Jen to assure her God would welcome her with loving arms if and when it came to be and she had nothing to fear but take solace that I knew this for a fact. SO, resy assured she is fine and her apin is no more. Our last visit she was in great spirits but I knew the pain she was in was excruciating, I could feel it. So God Bless her, her beautiful family and thank you for letting me join you yesterday after the funeral. It was my honor. And I'm right next door if Alisha or Trevor need anything at any timeof day or night.

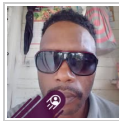
