People came from far away to get Fannie Lee's fried chicken and Carolyn's turnip greens. Jimmie Lee was a nurturing, quiet and reserved man. But when he spoke everyone

listened, he didn't have to repeat himself. He enjoyed watching wrestling on television and playing with all the children and giving them what they want. He never said "No" to them. They all were spoiled rotten by him. He kept the family laughing with his funny remarks. He went home to be with the Lord on July 8th, 2013. He leaves to cherish his memory, his wife Fannie Lee Hodge, 3 daughters Curine (Al) Smith, Mae Helen (Leroy) Robertson, and Carolyn Hodge, 1 son Jimmie Lee Hodge Jr. who preceded him in death.
