John Harris, Jr, was born on March 16, 1953 in Columbia, South Carolina. He was the son of the late John Harris Sr., and Mary Jane Bush Harris of Hopkins, South Carolina.

John was educated in the public schools of Richland County. He was a 1971 graduate of Hopkins High School. John excelled in athletics and was a member of the football and track teams. John enlisted into the United States Air Force in the Fall of 1971.

One year later John married his high school sweetheart, Brenda Loretta Ladson. They later added to this union two children: a son, John III, affectionately known as “John John”, and a daughter, Janna LeVisha.

After completion of his military service, John returned home and enrolled in South Carolina State College. Intrigued by math and science, John graduated with honors from South Carolina State College with a B.S. in Mechanical Engineering. John’s strong work ethic allowed him to be recruited after graduation in the corporate world by Proctor & Gamble. Later he accepted a position in Civil Engineering at Robins Air Force Base. During his time at Robins he worked on extensive, multimillion dollar projects.

Not only was John determined to excel in his career, but he worked diligently with Brenda as she pursued her dream in building a business. He provided substantial technological support while securing the family finances. Thereby, allowing the business to expand and relocate to Macon and later expand to Metro Atlanta. John was instrumental in the growth and development of the Metro Atlanta company’s success. Later on John returned to work fulltime in the Civil Engineering division at Dobbins Air Reserve Base in Marietta, Georgia. John worked with programs and methodologies consistently. After 29 years of federal service, John retired December 31, 2019.
