John E. Smith was born on November 2, 1951 in Atlanta, Georgia, at Grady Hospital to John and Ethel Smith. He was the fourth child of their union. Later in life, at almost 70 years old, he went on one of the biggest adventures of his life, skydiving. John also was an avid Georgia Tech fan and even named a room in his house in their honor called The Beehive.

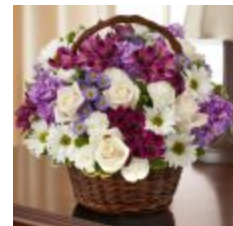
