Rest easy twin. I’ll carry your spirit with me in every step I take, until we meet again.

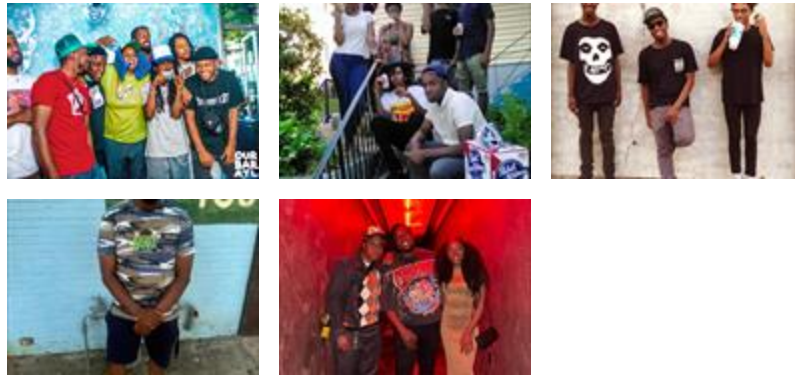

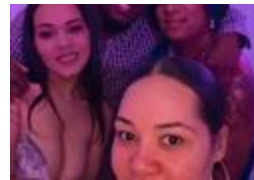

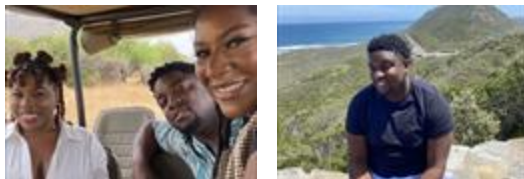
