Josie Mae Smith (Denson) was born to Joseph McKenzie and Eula Denson on October 1, 1937, in Montezuma, Georgia. Josie peacefully fell asleep in death on October 11, 2023, at home with her loving caregiver, Sophiat Arikewuyo, and two of her daughters, Laverne and Beverly.

At the age of 17, this small town “Georgia Peach” relocated to The Big Apple; New York City where she secured a job in The Fashion District as a seamstress. This is where she met her husband, Wilfred L. Smith.

Josie was a very nurturing woman. Though she gave birth to three sons and four daughters, and she also adopted a sibling group of three, two more sons and a daughter, she also fostered at least 25 other children, most calling her “Grandma.” She had a knack for taking on “at-risk infants” and sibling’s groups, making sure they could remain together. Many in the “Edenwald Houses” Community would also look to her as a mother or older sister. She was truly loved by all who crossed paths with her.

She was known for cooking and feeding not only her own children but anyone who was hungry. It was said that she made the best fried chicken ever! Her three sons, Charlie James Smith, Wilfred Smith, and Alfred Smith (identical twins), along with a brother, Edward C. Denson, preceded her in death.
