Kelli was also an active participant of the Delta GEMS Decatur Alumni Chapter

Kelli was an avid traveler; exploring England, France, and Mexico. She attended the 2008 Inauguration of President Barack Obama in Washington DC as well as attended numerous Girl Scout trips across the country.
