Kenneth Christopher Hewitt, 26, passed away unexpectedly on November 19, 2020 in Houston, TX. His death is a shock to the family and they are deeply saddened by this loss.

Kenneth was born on October 8, 1994 to Kenneth Ernest Hewitt and Crystal Kim Hewitt in Rockville Centre, New York. Kenneth moved to Lithonia, Georgia as an infant with his family, where he lived the majority of his life. As a young child, he exhibited many athletic gifts, having played in a youth soccer league, competed in karate, and was a skillful skateboarder. He also loved Japanese anime and popular shows like Pokemon and Yu-Gi-Oh as a young adolescent. He was an impressively self-taught musician and sketch artist. For high school, he attended Dekalb School of the Arts where he was able to sharpen his natural born gifts in music and art, and ascended the post of Captain of the Fitness Club. Kenneth was passionate about creating genre-bending music and played guitar, drums, piano, sang vocals, and was proficient in mixing & mastering songs in recording studios. He performed in several bands (There Were People with Morals, Escape Route 23, 10AM Automatic, etc.) where he wrote lyrics, produced music, and played various instruments. He loved to draw, create computer animation, and was working on an animated story using 3D rendering. Kenneth was also a very talented chef, who enjoyed cooking for himself and others.

All that met him knew that he was brilliant, creative, kind, loving, protective, and excelled at anything he put his heart into. He was a deep, philosophical, and beautiful soul.

Family and friends will miss him more than they can possibly put into words. Kenneth is preceded in death by his father Kenneth E. Hewitt. He is survived by his mother Crystal Hewitt, his brothers Lenaud Hughes and Darius Devlin, his sister Kiana Hewitt, sister-in-law Sam Hughes, and niece Leni Hughes - as well as a host of loving uncles, aunts, cousins, other relatives, and friends.

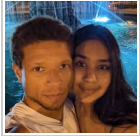

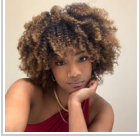
