Kenny lived by a bucket list. He was restoring his dad's Lincoln Mercury. He bought his dream car, a two-seater 2014 Mercedes-Benz SL-Class. He started playing golf, loved the game, and talked about the fun he had with his golf friends. For Kenny, the sky was the limit!
