Kevin Ian Bryan was born June 13, 1975 in Ontario, Canada to Denis and Shirley Bryan. Kevin was the second of their two children, joining his older sister Andrea.

From the beginning, Kevin had a lifelong passion for learning. He attended Alexmuir Junior Public School at 4 years old and was identified by a teacher for a gifted student program at Churchill Heights Public School. After emigrating to Atlanta in 1991, Kevin continued his studies at Stone Mountain High School where he graduated with Honors. He then went on to study at Georgia Tech and Southern Polytechnic University and attained not one, but three, four-year degrees in: Computer Science, Computer Engineering Technology, and Mathematics. He also achieved his Master's degree in Computer Science and was a member of the National Society of Black Engineers.

Kevin came from a long line of musicians. His Grandfather, Gladstone Bryan played the piano by ear, he was a piano tuner and technician in Jamaica. His Aunt, Constance Bryan was a well-known pianist who performed throughout the Islands and Europe. Grandfather Frederick Spence played the organ, piano, harmonica and accordion by ear.

Kevin continued the musical legacy when he began formal piano training at age 4. Kevin had such a love for music that he also learned to play music by ear. He also received Certificates from the Royal Conservatory of Music.

Kevin accepted the Lord as his Saviour and was baptized at the age of 8. He used his musical talents to glorify God by playing the piano, singing with various groups and directing choirs. His knowledge and love of all types of music was evidenced by his extensive music catalog. Kevin encouraged and inspired several young musicians in their craft.

Kevin loved video games, which he shared and played with his younger cousins. He also had an impressive collection of Rubik's Cubes and a vast library of comic books.

Kevin traveled to Oregon, California, Florida, Ohio, Michigan, Canada and finally settled back in Georgia with his IT consulting career. Wherever he lived, he used his musical talents to bless the church he was attending. Traveling also allowed him to indulge in his favorite pastimes, walking outdoor trails and attending the Symphony.
