Kizzie Bell went on to be with the Lord the morning of November 17th, 2023, at Northside Gwinnett Hospital in Lawrenceville, Georgia. She succumbed to complications from Sickle Cell Anemia and Kidney Failure.

Kizzie was born in Houston, Texas but was raised in Oakland California. She eventually moved to Georgia and settled with her children in the Gwinnett County area. She formed a community here and furthered her education at Georgia Gwinnett College where she proudly graduated in 2020. Kizzie was always an advocate for social justice and children of all ages, but especially for teenagers. Kizzie's love of teenagers brought her to serve faithfully and diligently at Victory Church in the youth ministry for over 10 years. Her commitment to her children and youth was at the forefront of her mission in life and her calling. She often took time to be a substitute teacher throughout Gwinnett County. Her passion for youth grew to include a community garden where she created a space for youth to grow and prepare nutritious food. Her desire was to see all children be successful and prosperous in first the Lord and in their everyday life was the driving force for continuing to fight through the toughness of her life. Through every battle that she faced she held on to her faith and to God's promises for her and her children, both biological and spiritual.

Kizzie is predeceased by her mother Mychune Bell and her father David

Whitfield. She is survived by her two sons Tysheen and Christian and her brother Olajuwon Bell. Kizzie will be cremated, and her ashes will be scattered by her sons at a later date.
