Landreth Fritz-Albert Edwards was a native of Stubbs, St. Vincent & the Grenadines. He attended Stubbs Primary School, and Emmanuel Secondary School. In 1971, he migrated to Brooklyn, New York where he attended Alexander Hamilton High School and graduated in 1973. After graduation, he joined the United States Marines, where he was discharged in 1977.

Landreth was known by many names – Lance, Showtime, and the most popular was Mr. Fritz. Mr. Fritz was a successful entrepreneur. He was a landlord. He started Fritz Plumbing and Heating, Lance Records and purchased a transmission repair company in Georgia. With these businesses, he had several partnerships. Many of his partners will attest that you couldn't turn your back on him, otherwise, you would be sorry, even if you were family.

Lance was a hard worker. His Marine training gave him the core strength, endurance and work ethics to complete a job. When others would retire for the night, he would continue until the job was done! If you were employed by Lance, it was more of an internship than employment. You were guaranteed a trade with a stipend. He trained many people and those who graduated from his tutelage are successful tradesmen.

In 1985, Lance married his childhood sweetheart Ermine Johnson. November 2024 would have been 39 years. He was a good provider to his 5 children,

Mandisa, Joey, Daniel, Octavia and Zandra, and his adopted children.

Lance's dream was to relocate back to his native land; however, plans changed and he relocated to Georgia when he was diagnosed with diabetes. He stated that he knew that it would catch up with him, but he was going to outrun it as long as he could. Thankfully, he accepted the Lord before the end of his race. Today we mourn him but not without hope.

The weeks and months ahead will be a challenge as we remember and miss Showtime. Pray for his wife, children, grandchildren, great grandchild, siblings, nieces, nephews, uncles, aunts and cousins that they would seek comfort and refuge in God.
