The Life of Mrs. Laquacer Desha Daniel

Laquacer Desha Daniel was born May 22, 1974 in Atlanta, Georgia to Mr. Eddie, Sr. and Mrs.

Eloise Smith. She shared her time in the womb with her beloved fraternal twin, Jaquacer, and

throughout life, they affectionately referred to one another as “womb-mates.”

They were the

older sisters of one younger brother, Eddie Smith, Jr. Laquacer was a loving wife, mother,

daughter, sister, niece, cousin, and friend who loved her family and friends dearly.

Laquacer accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized at Atlanta Bible Baptist Church under

Pastor Dr. John McNeal, Jr. There she received her spiritual foundation. She and her husband

later became an active member of Berean Christian Church Gwinnett, under Pastor Kevin B.

Lee, where she enjoyed serving on the Creative Ministry until her health failed in February 2019.

Laquacer grew up in a small, nurturing community in Decatur, Georgia surrounded by love and a close-knit family. She was educated in the Dekalb County Public School System beginning her education at Snapfinger Elementary School where she showed her academic abilities at an early age. She was placed in advanced Math courses by her fifth-grade year and during these formative years, she also displayed her creativity and passion for drawing often creating various hairstyles and fashions. She would submit her work in drawing contests, which fueled her passion even more. Laquacer possessed a natural ability to see “art” in anything and transform her creativity into a beautiful masterpiece. She would go on to attend Towers High School, and there, her passion continued when she created the Varsity Football banners for the school. During her tenure at Towers, she also participated on the Varsity cheer team, track and field, and the marching band. As she matured, her personality began to shine, and Laquacer became a true “Diva Girl,” always glowing with her hoop earrings, noticeable hairstyles, and fashionable clothing. She became an influencer even before it was popular to do so.
