Larry Leon Avery, fifth child of the late William Herman Lee Avery and the late Annie Lee Avery, made his transition on Sunday, August 28th, 2016.

He was born in Monroe, Georgia in Walton County. He received his early education at Social Circle Elementary School and Carver High School in the Walton County School System. While in high school, Larry played football and was a member of the debate team. In 1980, he graduated from Georgia State University with his Bachelors in Business Administration.

Larry was a veteran of the US Air Force, having served his country for over four years. While in the military, he was a serviceman in aircraft aviation. He flew on the first surveillance AWACS plane, which flew 24 hours a day dealing with National Security. He was privilege to have experienced flying around the world. Through the years, he worked for several companies, one of which was Motorola. However, Larry always had a heart for entrepreneurship. In 1985, he established his own business, Southeast Two-Way, a mass communication company, in the Metro-Atlanta area. Larry was also the Owner/CEO of KIMG, LLC, a company that fosters business partnerships between the United States of America and Africa. Larry enjoyed playing his harmonica, piano, gardening, softball, basketball, and golf. He was also known as the "Master Biz Wiz" and as "The Man of Spades." He so dearly loved to spend time with his family, especially his grandchildren. Larry Avery was a son of a pastor and was raised up in the church. In his early years, he attended Carters Hill Baptist Church in

Loganville, Georgia. In 1973, when he got married to Linda Moore, he became a member of Mt. Moriah Baptist Church off of N. Druid Hills Rd. in Atlanta, Georgia. Larry was well known for his loving, laid back, and pleasant personality. He was loved and admired by many, and fond memories of him will forever remain in the hearts of all who knew him.

Larry Avery was preceded in death by his father William "Herman" Lee Avery, his mother, Annie Lee Avery; one brother Herman "Bo" Avery Jr.; three sisters, Mary Nell Austin, Carolyn Render, and Marian Avery.
