On Monday June 17, 2024 Lascelles St. Clare Martin, affectionally known as Ken, loving husband and father of five children, brother and friend passed away at the age of 84 in Decatur Georgia.

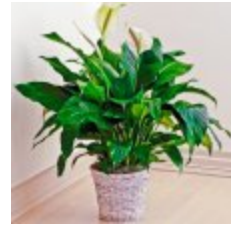
