Farewell, dear Latoya, beloved niece and caring nurse. May your spirit soar free, knowing that you are cherished, remembered, and forever cherished in many hearts.

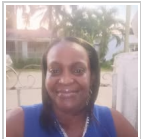

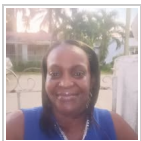

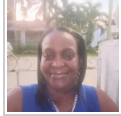

There's so many memories flooding my brain From growing up at grandma house.

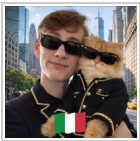
We just was never expecting this, the how's & why's continue to be a question for me. You just left us so unexpectedly & I'm seriously still in disbelief.
