Lenora Eunice Crockett, born September 12, 1940, entered into eternal rest in the loving arms of her Savior on December 4, 2025. She was the beloved daughter of the late Wesley B. and Cleadith Mae Witherspoon.

Lenora received her education in the East St. Louis school system and proudly graduated from Lincoln Senior High School, Class of 1959. Lenora's fondest memory of high school was being a part of the Lincoln High School marching band. Later that year, she married the love of her life, Deved Robert Crockett, and together they welcomed four children, who became the joy and focus of her life.

Lenora accepted Christ at an early age and lived a life firmly rooted in faith, compassion, and service. Lenora was a devoted member of First Baptist Church of Golden Garden, where she served faithfully as a deacon's wife, usher, and choir member. Her favorite hymn, "His Eye Is on the Sparrow," beautifully reflected her steadfast trust in God. She later became a Church Mother at The Faith House in O'Fallon, IL. After relocating to Atlanta, she joined Salem Missionary Baptist Church, remaining spiritually connected even when she was no longer able to attend in person.

Lenora was a proud and dedicated member of the Sigma Gamma Rho Philo Affiliate. Over the years, she held several leadership roles, including

President, Secretary, and Treasurer. She was honored many times for her commitment and contributions, and she cherished the fellowship, service, and sisterhood she found among her Philo sisters.

Professionally, Lenora was respected for her strong work ethic, integrity, and exceptional skills. She worked at the University of Illinois teaching families essential home skills; at Miss Elaine Sleepwear Factory, where she used her gift as a seamstress; at Edgemont/Regions Bank as a New Account Representative; and later retired as an Operations Supervisor with American Water Works Company. After retirement, she moved to Atlanta to be near her children and joyfully assisted her daughter Kim with her Van Horne Manor Event Venue.

Family was the heart of Lenora's world. She devoted her life to ensuring her children were supported academically, socially, and most of all spiritually. A committed member of the East St. Louis Senior High School Band Parents Association, she attended all of her children's, grandchildren's and great grandchildren's every event with pride. In her later years, she lovingly cared for her great-grandchildren until they reached school age.

She greeted them at the school bus each day—creating treasured memories that will last a lifetime.

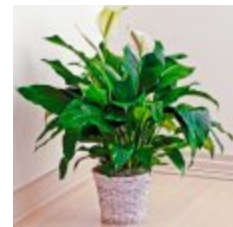
