Leo Armstead was born on June 1, 1941 in Fairhope, Alabama. He was son to the late Johnie Armstead and Ellena Sledge Armstead.

Leo graduated from Monticello High School in 1961. Leo met Annie when she was a senior in high school. He was then drafted into the United States Army and deployed to Vietnam. After returning home, Leo and Annie were married on December 16, 1972 and collectively have 3 sons, 2 daughters and 5 grandchildren.

Leo joined the Monticello Police Department as a patrolman and was later promoted to Detective. He was President of the Police Benevolent Association. He received the Silver Star of Bravery for capturing bank robbers. He also received the New York State Police Juvenile Specialist Association award. He also established and facilitated the Youth Court in Monticello New York.

After retiring from the Monticello Police Department, Leo continued his Community Service as an Administrator at Monticello High School. He always told the students, "Do what you have to do to get where you want to go."

In 2007, Leo and Annie moved to Snellville, GA. His community service continued. Leo was the president of the Home Owner's Association, Chairman

of Rules & By-Laws Committee, and President of the City of Snellville Planning Board.

Leo was an avid golfer and spent most of his retirement playing golf with his buddies.
