Bobby Rorie lived a life filled with purpose, adventure, love, and boundless energy. Born in the small town of Anson County, North Carolina, he never lost his country roots, even as he achieved dreams that took him far from home. Through education, determination, and an unwavering sense of self, he built a full and meaningful life—establishing his family’s home in Atlanta, Georgia, where he accomplished his greatest personal and professional goals as a Principal, Assistant Superintendent, and College Professor.

He was a devoted husband and best friend to his beloved wife, Dr. Vera Dixon Rorie, of 56 years. Their love was deep and special—a true partnership grounded in friendship, laughter, travel, and shared dreams. Together, they journeyed to over 20 countries, at times with their students, living a life of curiosity, adventure, and joy.

As a father and grandfather, Bobby (affectionately known as “Pops”, “Dad” and “Opa”) was deeply connected and profoundly proud. He poured his wisdom, energy, and love into his children and grandchildren, exposing them

to his adventurous spirit and teaching them life's most meaningful lessons along the way. He was an amazing storyteller, full of history and humor, and never missed a chance to tell a good "dad" joke or share a moment of laughter—even with strangers. He made everyone feel seen and welcomed, because he always showed up—with his whole heart.

Professionally, Bobby (a.k.a., "Doc" to close colleagues) was a leader in education administration, serving students across the country, from Minnesota to Georgia, as a Principal, Asst. Superintendent and Professor in both public schools and higher education. He retired in 2012, leaving behind a legacy of dedication to student success, equity, and excellence. He was also an all-around intellectual, a life-long learner, historian and family photographer who captured both moments and meaning with every click.

As a man in his 80s, Bobby defied every expectation. Most people were shocked to learn his age—his youthful energy, stylish dress, and active lifestyle kept him forever young. He loved music, sunshine, the beach, hunting, maintaining his beautiful lawn, and caring for his cars with pride. He stayed up to date on current events, engaged in his communities, and never stopped looking for ways to make the world around him better.

One of his greatest joys was riding his motorcycle—his favorite pastime for over 45 years. The open road was his freedom, and he traveled the country with his beloved Buffalo Soldiers Motorcycle Club, where he was known as "BullDawg" and whose brotherhood he

treasured deeply. He also held dear his lifelong bonds with the Freemasons and his fraternity, Kappa Alpha Psi. That he spent his final day riding—still seeking the thrill of adventure—is as fitting as it is heartbreaking. He could never sit still. He lived in motion, guided by a passionate heart and an endlessly curious mind.

Bobby was a God-centered man with convictions that drove his actions and his principled nature. He was a proud member of St. Philip AME Church in Atlanta for 38 years, but he began his spiritual journey in Gatewood Station, a small country church back in Anson County, North Carolina. He lived by the values he learned there - integrity, service, kindness, and devotion. He believed in doing the right thing. He gave unconditional love. And he did it all with the most welcoming and positive attitude you could imagine.

Bobby leaves behind a family that he was immensely proud of, who he never missed a chance to brag about. His absence is deeply felt—but his family is also deeply grateful and determined to honor the legacy he built with such care and grace.

Bobby lived a full life. He was a giant of a man in both spirit and heart. A beautiful example of how to live with joy, purpose, and love.

And whenever someone needed a little encouragement or assurance, he always had the perfect response:

“You bet!”

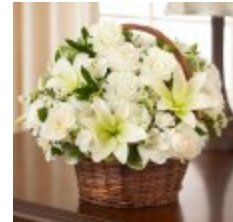

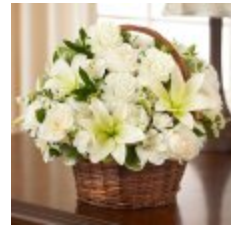

Please know that our thoughts and prayers are with you, the family, during this difficult time.

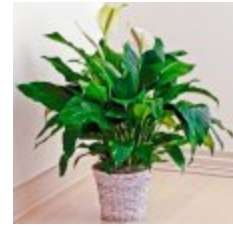
