



Lilleth Elizabeth Moody

September 22, 1940 - November 10, 2024

Lilleth Moody (affectionately called Rose, Rose Bud) entered this world on September 22nd, 1940. She was born to her mother Lillian McBean and her father Rudolph Moody. She was the sixth child of tenth children. During her formative years, she attended elementary school and later moved to Kingston where she resided with her three children. Lilleth, a hard worker, worked many jobs to support her family.

Lilleth, being a devoted and committed mother to her children, always wanting to ensure the best for them, encouraged them to relocate to the United States to join their father and his family in the late 70's. Later, she was able to be reunited with her children and grandchildren she joined them in Brooklyn, New York. Just as she dedicated herself to her children, she also selflessly took on the task of helping to raise her grandchildren while still working as a full-time caregiver to the elderly.

After retiring from being a caregiver she was faced with the challenge of fighting breast cancer. With a strong faith in God and the support of her family, she won this fight. In the late 2000's she relocated to Georgia to be with two of her children. Despite the challenges involved in battling cancer, she remained independent and active. With God at the forefront of her life, she willingly and without complaint gave of herself, her time, and her love to her family and extended her compassion to others.

Her health struggle with cancer would once again begin and result in her being in and out of the hospital. This struggle continued until September 2024, when the decision was made to send her home on hospice care where daughters Valrie and Donna supported her during this time, offering comfort, solace, and peace. She peacefully slept away on November 10th, 2024, transitioning to her heavenly home.

Lilleth Moody is survived by her three children, Audley, Donna, and Valrie, her five grandchildren, one brother Mateland, two sisters Verna and Petronella, her daughter-in-law, a host of nieces and nephews, her extended family members, friends, and well-wishers.
