Lillian’s Journey

Lillian was educated in the public schools of Walton Count. She attended Social Circle Training High School and graduated in the class of 1955. She later moved to Atlanta, Georgia for greater opportunities.

Lillian was united in marriage to Lewis Holmes, Jr. in Atlanta, Georgia in, 1957, who preceded her in death in 1982. There were no children to this union. Lillian later met the love of her life, Henry Michael Ayers, they were united in Holy Matrimony in 1990 and lived as Honeymooners in Sun City Peachtree Senior Community, Griffin, Georgia until his death in 2018.
