Lisa Wan was born on November 29, 1936, in Singapore, the second of five children in her family. She attended National Taiwan University where she met her future husband Lee, and the two emigrated to the Columbia, South Carolina, to begin their new life together in the United States.

In 1971, they moved to Atlanta, Georgia, where Lisa's professional career included work with K Mart and Sears Roebuck & Company. She also took courses at DeKalb Community College (now Georgia Perimeter). She and Lee were active in the Chinese-American community, and they were instrumental in building the Atlanta Chinese Christian Church's facility in Tucker.

Lisa was an avid tennis and golf player, and she enjoyed cheering on the Atlanta Braves and Tiger Woods. She was also a masterful mahjongg player and always relished the opportunity to spend time with her friends during numerous marathon game nights. She loved to travel (her favorite place being New Zealand) and took great delight in hosting dinner parties for guests to savor various ethnic cuisines. She also enjoyed watching Asian soap opera serials and had a penchant for tacos and margaritas, not necessarily in that order, and playing Ms. Pac-Man.
