August 16, 1952 - September 29, 2020

Ms. Lucy Carson, age 68, of Ellenwood, Ga passed away on Tuesday, September 29, 2020.

Lucy Mae Carswell Carson was the fifth child born to Earnest and Edna (Bryant) Carswell, Sr. in Jeffersonville, GA on August 16, 1952. Her parents preceded her in death along with her siblings, Marshall Carswell (wife: Ruby - deceased), Otha Carswell (wife: Mary Jane - living) , Laura Cole (husband: Waddell - living). Her surviving siblings are Earnest Carswell, Jr. (wife: Elnora) and Mack Carswell (wife: Genelda).

Lucy graduated with the last segregated class of Jeffersonville High School in 1970. She furthered her education at Fort Valley College where she met her college sweetheart, Luther Carson, Jr. The two entered into holy matrimony on December 21, 1974. Though the two love birds departed ways after 15 years of marriage, they remained good friends up through Luther's death in January 2001. Their union was blessed with two beautiful daughters, Lucita Abeni Carson (Alford) (aka Ahmanah Bath Yahawadah) and LuShauna Crechelle Carson. On February 11, 2010, Lucy was blessed with a grandson, Austin Alford through the union of Alvry (aka Hadar Ahmath Ban Yahawadah) & Lucita Alford. Austin became her pride and joy. She fondly called him her baby.

As Lucy raised her daughters, she made sure they were involved and connected to different cultures and living experiences. Some of the things she used to help mold and shape her daughters were Girl Scouts of America and Cedar Grove High School's Marching Band. She was heavily involved in both of these organizations as her daughters grew and matured.

Lucy was a very business oriented person and used this skill for over 30 years as an administrative assistant for Atlanta Metropolitan College ("AMC"). Due to her effectuations personality, she was able to build many lifelong friendships during her time at AMC. She leaves behind an array of former co-workers and former students whom she saw as family.

Lucy had a zeal for serving God. She began her spiritual journey at First Baptist Church of Jeffersonville, GA. This was the church of her youth where she was known for being a leader and heading the youth choir. Though in adulthood, she continued her spiritual journey at Cedar Grove United Methodist Church of Conley, GA ("CGUMC") she never lost ties with First Baptist Church and continued to support them throughout the years. She always referred to First Baptist Church as "home". During her time at CGUMC she was a devoted member up through the recent decline of her health. She was lovingly seen as a church mom. She enjoyed serving on various committees and boards. She took every position seriously and everyone knew her to be a "no nonsense" person. She was adored by both churches and will truly be missed.

Lucy was a treasure to her close-knit family and friends. She always sought ways to keep everyone together and connected. All of her cousins, nephews, nieces, and close friends knew they could call her for advice, a place to stay or just a laugh. She was a feisty woman who brought so much joy to her family and friends.
