Marlon's career also included approximately 12 years as a Cath-Lab Technician with Piedmont Healthcare and most recently he was employed

with Emory University Hospital until his health began to fail.

Marlon was preceded in death by his nephew Michael Jr., and his sister-in-law Tillet.
