Martha Lee Scott, 65, of Lilburn, GA, passed away on July 14, 2021, at her home. She was born May 31, 1956, in Washington, GA, Wilkes County Hospital, to Ezell and Catherine (Cheely) Scott, Warrenton, GA. She was the youngest of four children. She accepted Jesus Christ as her Lord and Savior at an early age and joined the New Salem Baptist Church, Warrenton, GA. In 2004, she joined the New Bethel AME Church, Lithonia, GA. After working there a few years, she sought employment in the hospital industry. She has worked at several hospitals in the metro Atlanta area as a Unit Secretary including Newnan Hospital, Newnan, GA; Georgia Baptist Hospital (now Atlanta Medical Center); Dekalb Medical Center (now

Emory Dekalb Medical Center); and Crawford Long Hospital (now Emory Midtown Hospital). Martha enjoyed her work which garnered her many accolades and recognitions for her efficiency and high quality of work as a Unit Secretary.

Martha was beloved by many people. She was a genuine sweet, kind, loving and generous person. She loved to eat out at the local restaurants and pubs in her younger days.
