



## Mary Nana Arthur Caulley

December 24, 1945 - April 14, 2022

Mary Nana Kwegyiriba Arthur was born on December 24, 1945 in Accra to Margaret Kwarley Quartey and Emmanuel Kwegyir Arthur. “Sister Nana” as she was affectionately called by everyone during her lifetime, started her primary education at Abossey Okai primary school in Accra and continued to the Kaneshie Methodist girls’ Middle school. She completed her middle form 4 and proceeded to Scriber secretarial school in Kokomlemle Accra. After graduating she worked as a secretary at the Korle-bu Teaching Hospital. Caring for people came naturally to Sister Nana, so while she was working at the hospital, she decided to pursue a career in nursing. Sister Nana enrolled in the Akim Oda Community Health Nursing Training school in the eastern Region, where she trained a Community Health Nurse.

Sister Nana was a devoted Christian who as a child was baptized into the Methodist church. While serving in the church as a chorister she met and married David Marquaye Caulley who was then the assistant organist. They had their son David in Ghana and Mary moved to the United States with her husband as he pursued his education.

Mary gave birth to their twin daughters Mary and Martha while in the states, then returned to Ghana and began working at Kaneshie Polyclinic. She later gave birth to their daughter Patience some years later.

After working at the clinic for some time, she applied to the Koforidua Midwifery training school in the eastern region to be trained as a midwife. Hard work was her hallmark and she continued to work at the Kaneshie polyclinic after qualifying as a midwife. When Mary was not at the clinic, she delivered babies for women in her community and did not require compensation for her service.

Sister Nana was a dedicated mother first and foremost. She treasured her children, grandchildren, nieces, and nephews and embraced every moment with them. In 1998 Sister Nana and her family returned to the United States where she continued to work in the healthcare industry. In 2010 she retired to enjoy and care for her grandchildren.

Mary lived by the scripture that says, "...be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving one another, just as God also forgave you in Christ" Eph 4:32. She sought out and helped many needy people. She was very humble, thoughtful, and respectful to the needs of others.

Mary took ill recently, and, on the afternoon of April 14, 2022, she peacefully passed away at home.

She is survived by her beloved husband, children, nieces, nephews, cousins, and grandchildren to mourn her passage to eternal rest.

Sister Nana Rest peacefully in the Lord. Rest in peace till we meet again.
