Michael was part of the Simonton School Chorus where he got to perform with students at community events including the Gwinnett County

Public Schools Board of Education meeting in April 2019 and the Gwinnett County Courthouse Christmas Celebration in December 2019. Michael also contributed to his school's media team and was a PTA volunteer on many occasions along side his Mom. Michael also sang with the New Mercies children's choir and enjoyed learning about the love of God in the Children's Church Youth Ministry.

Outside of school and sports Michael had a love for gaming. He enjoyed playing his most recent favorite Roblox on his computer. Michael's ambition was to become a Computer Scientist and he had already begun learning to code. Michael loved to laugh, had an amazing sense of humor, was humble and helpful. Michael came to know God through his time spent in church and daily evening devotions with him Mom at home. Michael passed away on the night of June 2nd 2021 after being hit by a motor vehicle while crossing a 6 lane intersection bike riding with his father and brother on Grayson Hwy and Web Ginn House Rd. Michael was resuscitated twice by the doctors at Children's Healthcare of Atlanta Egleston Hospital but was called home to be with his Heavenly Father. We are relieved that Michael now resides with the Angels.
