In the early afternoon of Wednesday, July 12, 2023, with his wife of almost 51 years, children, and grandchildren by his side, Michael G. Tate, Sr. passed away in Lawrenceville, Georgia.

Michael was born on September 22, 1953, to Willie Tate and Betty Clark in Knoxville, Tennessee. Michael graduated from Austin-East High School in 1971 and went on to study Accounting at Tennessee Tech University in Cookeville, Tennessee.

After graduating with a degree in Accounting, Michael began working at BellSouth in Memphis, Tennessee. Throughout his time with BellSouth, Michael and his family were transferred to Alabama, Louisiana, and finally Georgia, where he retired as Director of Payment Processing in 2007.

In 1969, Michael met Charlotte Bryant at Austin-East High School. Michael and Charlotte were married in 1972 and went on to have two children and three grandchildren.
