Mrs. Millicent E. Clarke of 5573 Strathmoor Manor Circle, Lithonia, Georgia, passed on from this life on Thursday, November 3, 2016. Shortly before she passed, she told her daughters that she was going to heaven. She was 69 years young.

Born on Sunday, February 23, 1947 in Waverly Cot, St. George, Barbados, she was one of six children of the late Ernesta “Fancy” (Clarke) Reece and the late Samuel Reece.

Millicent graduated from school in Barbados and at the age of 18, ventured to England to begin nursing school in 1965. She trained at Park Hospital (now Isebrooke Hospital) for three years and became an Enrolled Nurse in January 1968. Millicent married her late husband, Leon R. Clarke on March 16, 1968 and the union produced three daughters. In 1977, Millicent returned to Barbados for a few short years with her daughters, before reuniting with her husband, in Springfield, Massachusetts, in 1984. There, Millicent worked for the Visiting Nurses Association and held various positions in retail.

In August 1989, Millicent was proudly baptized in church. She was known to have said that her three favorite things were church, her daughters and food. In 2001, Millicent moved to Georgia to be cared for by her daughters and enjoy the warmer climate. She recently enjoyed fellowship, friendship and singing at the Greater Faith International Ministries church in Lithonia,

Georgia.
