Milrose Drucilla Mack was born in St. Johns, Antigua, West Indies on November 4, 1932, to the late Winfred Francis. She was preceded in death by her sister, Iola Crump, her daughter, Camilla Joseph, and grand son-in-law, Kaigua Kagiri.

She was married to the late Leon Roy Franklin Mack. The union produced four children: Derrick, Sharon, Ellsworth & Julia. They moved to St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands to secure a better living for the family.

Milrose faithfully performed her duties for 19 years as an employee for the Government of the Virgin Islands, Department of Special Education. She retired in 1997.

Milrose accepted Jesus Christ at an early age and inclined her heart to follow His will.

She was a former member of the City Seventh-day Adventist Church and a member of the choir. As the field of harvest began to ripen, she became a member of the Maranatha Seventh-day Adventist Church, both located in St. Thomas Virgin Islands. While at Maranatha she served as a deaconess, community service ministry member and participated in many outreach ministries. Upon moving to Georgia, she became a member of Hope

Tabernacle SDA Church in Snellville, Georgia.

Milrose, being a lady of faith, and determined to see her Lord and Savior, lived a frugal lifestyle. She can be described, by those who knew her, as simple in the world's goods but abundant in the faith, knowledge and wisdom of God. She took care of the sick and shut-in, helped those in need and supported the ministry of the gospel of Jesus with her time and finances. She also loved to sew and bake. She was a great cook but would never divulge any of her secret as to why her food tasted so delicious.
