Milton Jerel Kimbrough was born on March 19, 1972, in Anniston, Alabama, to the late Milton Joe and Janice Elanor (Crook) Kimbrough. He was the eldest of three children and from a young age was known for his kind heart, thoughtful spirit, and deep love for family. As a boy, Milton joined Bethel Missionary Baptist Church in Alexandria, Alabama, where his faith began to take root and grow. In November 2011, he joined Beulah Missionary Baptist Church in Decatur, Georgia.

He was educated in the Anniston City School System and graduated proudly with the mighty Class of 1990 from Anniston High School. Milton continued his academic journey at Alabama A&M University in Huntsville, Alabama, where he earned a Bachelor of Arts degree in History with a minor in Political Science.

Milton dedicated his professional life to serving others, working with troubled youth and disabled adults across Alabama and Georgia. Through his work with AmeriCorps and the Georgia Department of Juvenile Justice, Milton became a mentor, guide, and advocate—pouring his heart into making a difference in the lives of those who needed it most. His compassion and empathy touched many lives, and his work reflected the love he carried in his heart. In October 2015, a devastating illness changed the course of his life, yet Milton continued to persevere with unwavering strength and faith, a true

testament to his resilience and courage.

On April 5, 1996, Milton was blessed with the joy of fatherhood when he welcomed his daughter, Jordan Christina Davis, into the world. He was incredibly proud of her and loved her deeply—his love for Jordan was one of the brightest lights in his life.

On November 4, 2016, Milton was united in marriage to Kimberly Jane Wilson, his childhood friend and lifelong companion. Their story began in the backyards of their families' homes and blossomed into a beautiful union rooted in shared memories, deep connection, and abiding love.

On April 9, 2025, Milton peacefully transitioned into eternal rest. God, in His divine mercy, called Milton home to a place of everlasting peace—a place free of pain and filled with joy, where he is now reunited with his beloved parents, Milton Joe and Janice Kimbrough; uncles Anthony Crook, Robert Kimbrough, Horace Tramble; and aunt Pearl McDonald.

Milton's life and legacy will be forever cherished by those who love him. He leaves behind His devoted wife, Kimberly J. Kimbrough, his loving daughter, Jordan C. 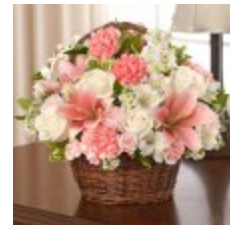

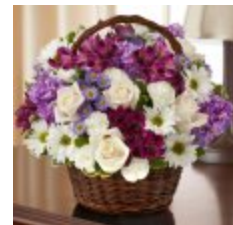
