Nathan Patrick Taylor was born on July 19, 1966 in Monroe, Louisiana to Mattie Lovern Taylor and Kenneth Anderson. Nathan was a baptized and was member of St. John Baptist Church in Bastrop, Louisiana where he was a very active member. In his early years and throughout his life, Nathan was greatly influenced by, and received guidance from his Aunt Pat, who like a mother to him. Nathan graduated from Bastrop High School in May 1984 where he played basketball and was known as a great guy and for keeping his classmates laughing. In April 1985, Nathan enlisted in the Air Force ROTC Program under Unit 917 CAMS and he trained at Lackland Air Force Base in Texas. His primary specialty title was Aircraft Armament Systems Specialist. Nathan has been a member of The American Legion since 2014.

He graduated from Louisiana Tech University located in Ruston, Louisiana in May 1989 with Bachelor of Science degree in Finance. He pledged Kappa Alpha Psi in the Spring of 1988 under the Theta Rho Chapter while at Louisiana Tech. He was known as "Passion Nate". He was on the Kappa Alpha Psi Step Team which was well known throughout the South for winning many step competitions. Through his Fraternity, Nathan volunteered and participated in fundraisers for Ruston High School.

After graduating from college, Nathan moved to Atlanta, Georgia and worked in finance for GE Capital, Holiday Inn Worldwide Headquarters/Bass Hotels, and Assurant. He later took an interest in HVAC work and was a trained

profession in this field. He also established his own business, Taylor Transport Express, LLC in 2017 and was in the process of establishing a delivery contract with Amazon. As a lover of basketball, Nathan joined an intramural basketball league where he played for several years.

Known to his friends as “Cowboy Nate” and “The Cowboy”, Nathan loved country music and was often seen wearing cowboy boots and his signature black Stetson hat. There are many videos out there featuring Nathan’s karaoke singing skill! He was an avid golfer and part of the “Nupes on Tour” annual golf tournaments. He enjoyed playing poker and he was a committed Cowboys and LSU fan. One of Nathan’s other passions was for his Harley Davidson motorcycles. He loved to ride and often took extended rides through the mountains and across states on his bike. Nathan loved to travel, and at any point in time, he would take off on a trip to see places he had never experienced.

Nathan has been described as a fun, loving and giving man who was always the life of party. He would lend a hand to anyone in need, never met a stranger and loved others deeply. He had a very gentle spirit and was often quiet and introspective. He loved his family, but his greatest love was reserved for his daughters, London and Lourdes.

Nathan was preceded in death by his loving mother, Mattie Taylor-Towns; brother, Daniel Mario Towns; sister, Pamela Michelle Towns; and grandparents, Edd Turner and Lucille (Billie) George-Bryant. 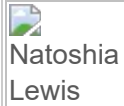

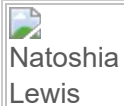

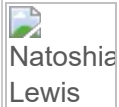
