



Mother Norena Pierce

April 12, 1932 - June 16, 2024

Minister Norena Pierce was a caring loving wife, mother, grandmother, sister, aunt, cousin and friend. She was an ordained minister who served in leadership positions in the Georgia General Assembly of the Church of God. She was born on April 12, 1932, in Bulloch County Georgia to Willie Jones and Ollie (Hendrix) Jones. She answered the Master's call at 3:00 AM on June 16, 2024. Norena was a longtime Screven County,

Georgia resident who attended the Screven County School system. She grew up and spent much of her young life balancing the needs of the family farm against the available education. Norena was joined in Holy matrimony with Robert Pierce in July 1949. From this union they had nine children: Imogene (akalmogeneCoco), Robert Louis (aka Olushola J. Lutalo), Arlene, Voncille, Dorsey Mack, Ray Timothy, Caleb Demetrius, Joshua Mitchell, and Hubert Dwayne. Norena accepted Christ at an early age and became a dedicated member of the Church of God. Norena sought to teach her nine children her cherished beliefs. As a pastor's wife and mother, she was an active participant in many church activities working by her husband's side in numerous revivals, youth camps, and conventions.

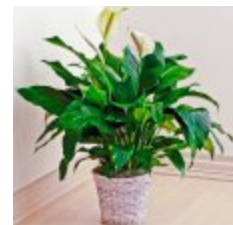
