Paul Lenard Wesley was born June 11, 1950, in Savannah Georgia to Earline Hagood Wesley and Sumpter Wesley. 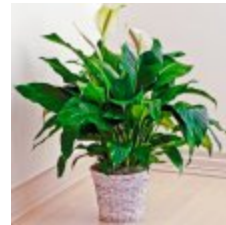

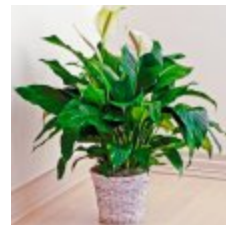
