OUR FATHER MADE MANY FRIENDS IN THIS LIFE AND WE NEVER SAW HIM ILL. HE WAS A GREAT MAN OF GOD. OUR FATHER BECAME A MEMBER OF DECATUR 7TH DAY ADVENTIST CHURCH AND BECAME ACTIVE IN MUSIC, PRISON, AND NURSING
