Phillip Royce Reid, Jr. was born December 10, 1981 to Phillip Roy Reid, Sr. and Heidi “Porsche” Hopkins at UCLA Medical Center, Los Angeles, California. Phil Jr. was the oldest of three sons. Phillip resided in West Palm and Boynton Beach, Florida where he attended Berkshire Elementary School, Congress Middle School and Atlantic High School. Later Phillip moved to Georgia, attending Grayson High School. During these years Phillip played the trumpet, and was stellar at football, basketball, and track.

Phillip had a unique character that could only be adored. He was a people person, well loved by others where no one was a stranger. He was fun loving and would light up a room with his entry. He had an infectious personality which kept all laughing and guessing. He was God-fearing and would often say “God Knows My Heart.”
