Raymond Faverey, 82, passed away at Piedmont Henry Hospital on Monday, September 11, 2017. He was born in Brooklyn, New York on December 21, 1934. He was born to the late Florian Faverey and the late Daisey Faverey, who migrated from Suriname, South America.

Raymond spoke the native language of Suriname, as well as fluent Dutch. He lived in Germany and worked for the United States Embassy and spoke German as well. college, Raymond and Charmaine moved to Atlanta, Georgia to be with her. Raymond was a gentleman, soft spoken, funny, and a pleasure to be around. He was the epitome of a man. Raymond and Charmaine were married for 33 years.
