It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Mr. Reuben Andrew Miller, former Passenger Service "Red Coat" Agent of Delta Airlines, on Tuesday, October 19, 2021 in Atlanta, Georgia. Reuben served as a police officer and detective for the Jamaican Constabulary Force prior to migrating to the United States in 1968. Shortly thereafter, he was hired by Delta Airlines and remained with the airline for over 30 years. He was best known for providing superb customer service and key airline liaison for the Atlanta Jamaica Association, the Southern Christian Leadership Conference and the Atlanta-Montego Bay Sister Cities efforts. In addition to his professional, civic and servant leadership, Reuben was also known for being a kind and loving human that many lovingly called "Uncle Reuben." He was a friend, mentor and icon to many and will be missed by all who were blessed to know him.
