Dr. George Moore, former Senior Pastor (retired), known as the Master Pastor, of 42 years of Saint Philip African Methodist Episcopal Church, Atlanta, Georgia received his victory on February 8, 2015 at 4:22 AM. Pastor Moore was one of the largest contributors to the African Methodist Episcopal Church worldwide, so it was only fitting that he would transition on Founder's Day for the African Methodist Episcopal Church and because of his love of the Lord Jesus Christ, family, and the Kingdom of God that he is being buried on Valentines Day. 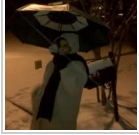
