Retired Deputy Sheriff Robert (Bob) Patterson, entered this world on September 26, 1951 in Atlanta to the late Timothy and Susie (Allen) Patterson. He went home on 12/08/2020 at 0945 hrs. He was a beloved husband, father, and a friend to many. Robert graduated from Murphy High School where received a recommendation for advancement in the Senior Division ROTC. He attended Atlanta Area Technical School, Gwinnett Technical College, and Georgia State College. He received his Bachelors degree in Respiratory Therapy.

He began his journey through the Armed Forces; beginning with the U.S. Army in 1975 Fort Benjamin Harrison, Indiana. Serving throughout with different trainings in the Army. He was Honorably discharged from the Army and moved on to serve in the Georgia National Guard in 1987, from there he also served in the U.S. Air Force. He and many of his brothers and sisters in uniform were held in High Honors by the Department of Defense for their participation in Forsyth County Security Operation.

He was a member of Beulah Baptist Church in Atlanta, Georgia. While in the Atlanta area he worked for Grady hospital in the ER, and the Neonatal Unit. He also worked on the Grady ambulance service. As well as working for

Dekalb Fire Department EMS and moved to the Dekalb police department. He left there and worked for MARTA police later moved to the Gwinnett County Sheriff's Department. While he worked for Gwinnett County Sheriff's department he helped to change many lives through his dedication to the job and his love for his fellow man.
