Robert Thomas Jr. was born on April 7, 1941 in Mayfield, GA. He was the second of seven children born to the late Robert Thomas Sr. and Nancey Moss Thomas. On August 9, 2020, God called him from labor to reward.

Robert received his formal education in the Hancock County school system. Having no more than a 9th-grade education, he learned the art of brick masonry from Dekalb Tech. After working for Frank Bailey for some years, he decided to become the owner and operator of Robert Thomas Jr. Construction Company. Having a heart for people especially those in need, he hired just about anyone who needed a job. Robert worked tirelessly for over 40 years until his health failed.

On October 11, 1964, Robert married the love of life Annie Maude Bell residing in Gwinnett County. From their union five children, Sheila, Darrel, Audrey, André, and Patrick were born. He loved his family and likewise, they loved him. As the patriarch of the Thomas family, everyone looked to him for guidance and gave him the utmost respect.

Robert accepted Christ into his life and joined the former Moses Tabernacle F.C.O.G.I.C. where his masonry skills helped facilitate the construction of the

edifice. After serving as a faithful choir member, Sunday School teacher, and Deacon, Robert received his calling to preach. On November 29, 1992, he was ordained as an Elder.
