Rosa Louise Moore was born in Atlanta, Georgia, on May 27, 1945, to Minnie Mills Davis and Samuel Davis. She was raised in the Edgewood neighborhood along with her sister, Sandra, where she attended Wesley Elementary and Howard High School. She was a devoted member of the Howard High School class of 1963 where she developed lifelong friendships.

As a teenager, she was one of the first African Americans to work for the Braves baseball team as an usher.

Following her graduation from Clark College in 1968 with a degree in political science, she went to work for Georgia Power as one of the first African American customer service agents. She remained a dedicated employee for over thirty-five years until her retirement. She again gained many lifelong friends during this time.

As a young adult, she joined the Catholic Church and remained a dedicated member of Saint Peter and Saint Paul for over forty years. She loved her church and actively participated in many church activities.

Her favorite role was being a devoted and loving mother to her two children, Dr. Sircy Moore (Christine) and Stephanie Moore, who she shared with Robert Moore. During their

childhood and beyond, she was involved in their school, sports, and extra-curricular activities. Her love and support for them was infinite.

Her other great loves were the many animals she had over the years, including her beloved dogs, Onyx and the late Peke. During her retirement, she loved volunteering at the PAWS Atlanta animal shelter.
